Penalty Notices



Following consultation with the Education Welfare Officer and an increase of children missing school due to unauthorised holidays, the School, along with the Governors have decided that from September 2018 fixed penalty notices will be issued for unauthorised holiday absences. This could be a fine of a minimum of £60 for each child, per parent (e.g. the minimum fine for two children with two parents would be £240).
