We have been so busy in the afternoon, with the start of a new exciting curriculum. We have been learning about how the globe is divided up in Geography by using longitude and latitude lines. In History, we have begun investigating all about World War 1 or the Great War as we found out it was known as. Although it started 108 years ago, we know we can learn lessons from looking closely at the past. The heart is our area of focus in Science and we have learnt what its role is in keeping us healthy.

Our focus in RE is Gifts from God and we are reflecting and rejoicing in God's love as we explore Creation stories and the gifts given to us through our faith. Each week we are having collective worship where we express our love for God together as a class.

In reading we have begun reading ROOFTOPPERS by Kathrine Rundell and we have been using it for our whole class guided reading. We have begun an interesting unit of work in writing leading to writing part of an autobiography. With the weather being so fine, we have enjoyed our PE lessons where we are learning the skills to play Tag Rugby – Mr Pepper might even teach how to perform the Haka!

Finally, this week we have split into our Maths classes and begun focusing on place value.








When you enter the school grounds, please only do so through the pupil gates.
