## Planned Spending of Sports Premium Funding for 2022/23 - £18,750

The sports premium funding has been budgeted under 5 key indicators:

## 1. The engagement of <u>all</u> pupils in regular physical activity (£6,000 set aside for this).

Legendary legends, trained mid-day supervisors, lunchtime provision with rugby, basketball and football.

#### 2. The profile of PESSPA being raised across the school (£3,000 set aside for this).

3 athlete visits planned. We have already had one, Pete Thompson is coming back in with a behaviour programme for Year 5/6 and we are going to have at least one more female athlete visit.

#### 3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills in all staff (£3,000 set aside for this).

2 CPDs not yet booked for this as CSSP is no more. Dance and Gymnastics are an area of focus for our school. We also have PE support for an ECT with CUFC and we will offer this also to our other ECT in Spring term.

# 4. Broader range of activities and sports offered to all pupils (£4,000 set aside for this).

We have an active Science budget and money set aside for team building days for all classes. Also, scooter wise and bikeability.

## 5. Increased participation in competitive sport (£2,000 set aside for this).

This is to allow pupils to attend competitions.

The total PE spending plan budget is £18,750. The amount set aside equals £18,000.
