



## Reception Overview for the Week: 8<sup>th</sup> January 2018

<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>Maths</b></p> </div> <p>In Maths this week we are learning to count an irregular arrangement of up to twenty objects.</p> <p>Vocabulary we will be using: Number, zero, one, two, three... ten, how many....?, count, more, less, listen, join in, look at, point to, show me, same number, same way, pattern, group, set, start from , arrange</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>English</b></p> </div> <p>In Literacy this week we will be starting our stories based around Traditional Tales. We will be focusing on stories that contain “Amazing Vegetables”, such as Jack and the Beanstalk, The Giant Turnip and Cinderella.</p> <p>The Children will be writing a review of the Pantomime we saw “Jack and the Beanstalk”</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>Physical Development</b></p> </div> <p>We are starting our Games module and will be learning the expectations in PE: To share the area safely and to move safely around others. To develop control of movements when moving at speed</p> <p>We are continuing to learn how to change for PE. Where possible the children are expected to change themselves with a little adult support. Please help them to become independent when changing – thank you!</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>Phonics</b></p> </div> <p>We will be learning Set 8 of our Phase 3 sounds: /ch/, /sh/, /th/ and /ng/</p> <p>The children will practise blending and segmenting words containing these sounds.</p> <p>They will also be practising reading and spelling high frequency words, including he, she, we, me, be, was, my, you, her, they, all, are.</p>
<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>KUW</b></p> </div> <p>We will preparing our patch of garden for the growing season by digging out weeds and talking about what vegetables we would like to grow,</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>RE</b></p> </div> <p>We are learning more about Jesus as a child and starting to hear about the stories as he grew. This week we are focusing on the story of Jesus in the Temple</p>	<p><b>Other news and reminders:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you have any spare or unwanted seeds, or maybe cuttings from plants that we could use in our garden we would love to have them!</li> <li>• <b>Home Learning Activities:</b></li> <li>• The children will be coming home with reading books.
