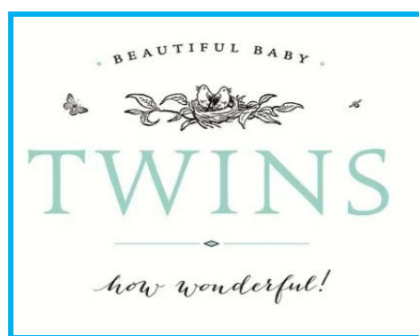

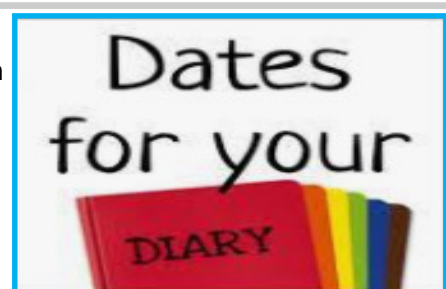
We were so happy to be able to hold our traditional Nativities this year - even with a somewhat depleted audience!
